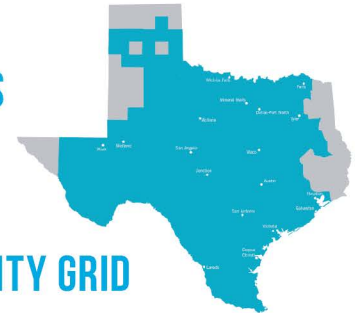

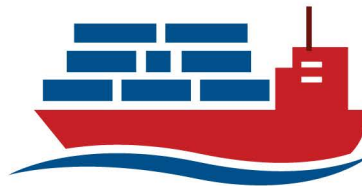


TEXAS IS THE LARGEST ENERGY-PRODUCING STATE IN THE NATION
